**There's a lot to catch up on since the last time.** I seem to always write that in my newsletters but this time it is no less true!

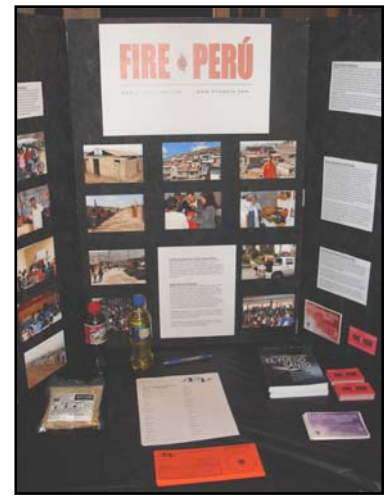


**Since the last time I updated, I got to teach four sessions on divine healing** to pastors and leaders in Huachipa, using the curriculum of an established healing ministry. We had about 48 students, all leaders in various ministries who've never had formal seminary training. We worked long hours and they made a sacrifice to attend a twice a week Bible class on DVD. For our sessions we taught and practiced in person, and the students laid hands on one another on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> nights to practice what they'd been learning. Several of them testified of results they'd seen when stepping out and trusting God to heal the sick and lame in the streets and at their jobs. **It encouraged me so much to not just see more healings, but to encourage other people to step out into it as well and witness results!**



**Around the end of September** and the first part of October, I attended the Tenth Annual FIRE International Missions Conference. It was good to see my leaders, visit with old friends, and raise more needed support. I was also privileged to be a guest for a brief segment on Dr. Michael Brown's radio show, "The Line of

FIRE." He is the author of the "Holy Fire/Fuego Santo" book *Fire Peru* had translated and printed. If you go to the website link for the first hour of Oct 9<sup>th</sup> you can hear us discuss the book and some of the things God is doing in Peru and how ripe it is for God to spread revival fire.



**Every fall is the time of year many sponsors of mine renew their financial support or new ones start.** This is in part due to the timing of this conference, many of the *FIRE International* missionaries coming out to North Carolina every fall, where FI's base is located, and by my being in Canada usually for a time in the fall as a result. Therefore, I want to put a little bit of our vision for 2010 in writing, to give you an idea of where we're going and heading.

**Beginning in January we're going to be starting up our Bible school again**, which will meet weekly for teaching and bi-weekly opportunities for street evangelism. This will provide me more opportunity to get more integrated as a teacher of the Word of God. Our *Centro de Fuego* (Fire Center) Church is growing—we've moved from a classroom in a school to a fellowship hall in that school! **We're also planning on hosting another FIRE conference in July or August where we're expecting larger numbers than our first.** Also, we're in talks to print more copies of the Holy Fire book, and to translate and print other works by authors we're close to. The cost of printing in Peru is far cheaper than anything possible in North America, but at this point the expenses are still greater than *Fire Peru* as a non-profit ministry. **If you'd like to be kept up to date on the different book publishing opportunities and special projects, please check out our new website at [www.fireperu.org](http://www.fireperu.org)** which will contain opportunities to give. And don't forget to subscribe to our podcast 'Fire On Your Head' where we're frequently taking 5-10 minutes during every show intro to update on the latest happenings— you'll get blessed with some solid and practical Bible teaching/discussions as well. There are buttons on each site for how you can give towards the book printing at \$3.50/copy.

**I'm also personally increasing my monthly support to accommodate rising ministry expenses** (separate to my normal living –which I'm currently not struggling with at the moment—thanks to my faithful supporters whom I appreciate!) However, upcoming traveling opportunities have opened up, including a trip to the jungles in Northern Peru in November and again this upcoming May 2010, to minister to people hungry for a move of God in that area. **Several of these dear leaders traveled by boat for 7 days in order to attend the conference in Lima last August. I figure if they can give up so much to attend a conference with speakers they never heard of in order to catch the fire, then so can I in order to go to them with our team.** I also plan to return to North America at least once in the next year.

**If you've been sitting on the fence about if you would like to commit to supporting me for the next year,** please know that myself and most missionaries don't live on a surplus, and are doing things bigger than us that we're trusting God to provide for. Donations can be done online (USA only at this point) or through the remit envelope enclosed in this newsletter. That's my spill for money for the year. I thank you in advance for partnering with me to reap the harvest in Peru, and to see a move of God in South America and beyond!

**Of course, I first and foremost ask you not to forget to pray for me.** The intensity of the spiritual battle is not overwhelming me but I've been increasingly reminded that we have an enemy who HATES when we're destroying his kingdom and setting captives free. I appreciate all of you that lift me up in prayer to withstand the enemy's schemes.
